The School of Design in the College of Imaging Arts and Sciences at the Rochester Institute of Technology invites applicants to apply for a non-tenure track Lecturer position to teach in the Industrial Design program. We are seeking candidates that are well-rounded designers and educators with significant professional experience. Candidates should be qualified to teach throughout the Industrial Design curriculum. Primary responsibilities will be teaching professional practice, design history, and studio based courses.

Responsibilities include teaching up to four classes each term.

The position begins **August 15, 2013**.

Required Qualifications

- MFA in Industrial Design or a terminal degree in a related field of study (completed by June 2013), or BFA/BA in Industrial Design and a minimum of ten years professional experience.

- Teaching experience at the university level beyond a teaching assistantship.
- Professional, conceptual, historical and practical understanding of the profession.
- Knowledge of professional practices, design history, design principles and methodology.
- Experience in Adobe CS applications.
- Experience in 3D modeling software.
- Ability to contribute in meaningful ways to the college's continuing commitment to cultural diversity, pluralism, and individual differences.
